Karl Dollhopf discussed the completion of summer school. Fifty students attended the five week program with focus on math and reading. Brady Downey thanked Hannahville Indian Community for awarding the High School a 2% Grant of \$10,000. The High School was able to purchase 12 multi-media projectors and 2 interactive modules (smart board technology). Steve O'Driscoll commented that he has been on the School Board for 5 years, been through 15 budgets / budget revisions and that our Business Manager, Mike Macfarlane, is top-notch with our school finances.
